Operator responsibilities for lift and ramp boarding

- Pre-trip checking of lift/ramp operation
- Deploying lifts and ramps safely
- Proper order of boarding and alighting
- Providing assistance to passengers
- Ensuring passenger safety on lifts and ramps
- · Maintaining proper body posture and clearances to prevent injury to yourself
